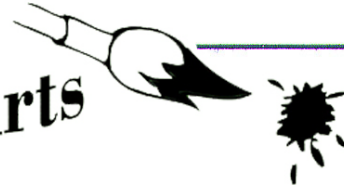


# Festival of the Arts



Dear Late Bloomer Grant Applicant,

You are invited to apply for a 2010 Festival of the Arts Late Bloomer Grant. The purpose of the grant program is to encourage individuals over 50 to reach their artistic potential by providing them with a monetary grant to develop their skills in an area by taking classes, seminars, obtaining supplies, etc. Grants are awarded for undertaking activities to develop your skills rather than to produce a product.

The Festival of the Arts, an independent, nonprofit volunteer organization, will award up to \$1,000 in grant monies. Grants are awarded based on artistic potential. There are no financial need criteria. The winning recipients are selected by anonymous independent grant review committee made up of experts in various artistic fields. The committee changes each year. Applicant names are deleted from materials submitted to grant committee to retain their anonymity. The number of winning recipients will be determined by how far the \$1,000 will stretch! Grant recipients will be notified by July 15<sup>th</sup> and the grants will be awarded at a Special Grant Publicity meeting in July.

## **Criteria:**

Open to individuals age 50 and above who live in Brookings Harbor or the larger area extending south to Crescent City, north to Port Orford and east to Gasquet.

Open to all creative artistic fields including but are not limited to fine art, photography, woodwork, sculpting, pottery, writing, poetry, metal work, music, etc.

*The applicant must demonstrate talent in a relatively new artistic field, and document how the grant will assist in the development of that talent. The grant is not meant to be used to produce a product.*

**Application Deadline is June 15, 2009 and must include:**

***A completed Application with specific additional information attached.***

***Photographs*** of your work. (You may be asked to show your actual work at a later date). Do not submit actual work initially.

***Specific itemized list of what you are requesting***, including source and cost.

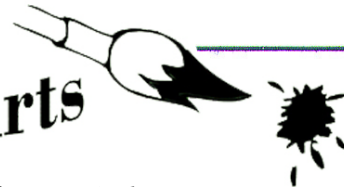
Other pertinent information you feel may assist the review committee in considering your request. eg. background information, goals, etc.

***Submissions are judged on their overall presentation.***

***Photographs of your work must be included with your application.*** Please do not include original work. NOTE: If accepted for a grant, photographs will not be returned and may be used for publicity purposes.
